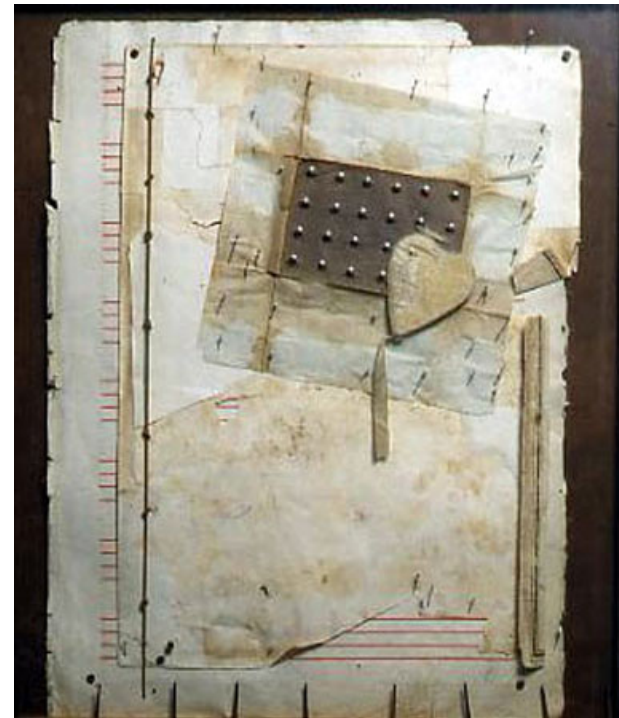

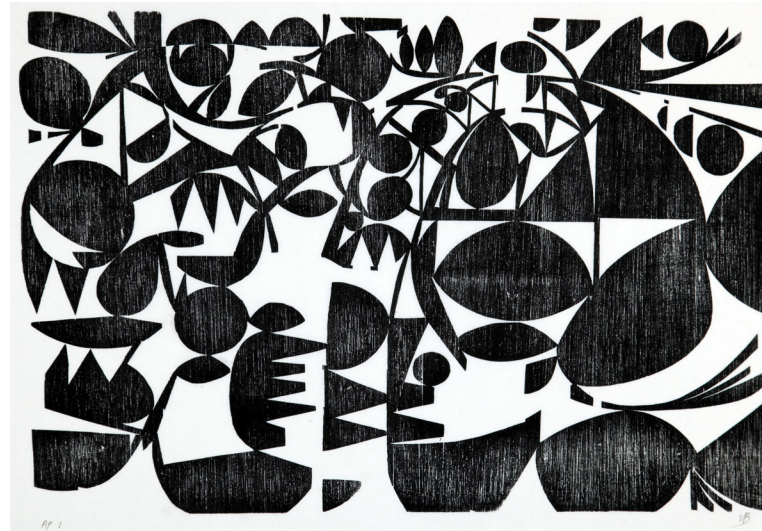

The following are works culled from the Provincetown Art Association and Museum's permanent collection celebrating Varujan Boghosian and his peers. Many have been part of Long Point Gallery, a cooperative gallery founded by 13 artists. Long Point artists included in this exhibition are: Varujan Boghosian, Fritz Bultman, Sideo Fromboluti, Edward Giobbi, Budd Hopkins, Robert Motherwell, Paul Resika, Judith Rothschild, and Tony Vevers. Varujan Boghosian incorporates found objects discovered at the beach, flea markets and antique stores in his assemblages. These objects incorporate nostalgia, symbolism and often humor as part of a narrative. In particular, he utilizes the myth of Orpheus, the god of Poetry and music to explore "the nature of identity" a theme that runs throughout Boghosian's work. Boghosian is a master of visual poetry through his eloquent placement of objects and monochromatic use of color and texture.
