Scholarship Funds

to be offered to a Local High School Student for a Summer Workshop at PAAM

Are you a local High School Student interested in painting, drawing, printmaking, art history, or photography?

The Provincetown Art Association and Museum wants **YOU** to participate in our summer workshop program! **The Robyn Watson Scholarship** will be offered to an interested high school student (graduating seniors welcome). The scholarship was created to honor the memory of the late Director's dedication to quality education at PAAM. Scholarship funds are provided to attend one summer workshop and preference is given to Provincetown High School students. (Students from other schools are also encouraged to apply.)

You can choose from over 60 workshops including painting out of doors, drawing from the model, bookmaking, sculpture, and white line woodblock printmaking. Workshops will run June through August, are generally 3 days to 1 week long, and are limited in size—from 6 to 12 students—to maintain a supportive and engaging art-making environment.

Interested? Need help? Talk with or email Curator of Education Lynn Stanley! She can help you choose a workshop and answer your questions. A letter of interest stating why it's important for you to take a class at PAAM, which classes you'd be interested in, and evidence of financial need is required as part of the application process.
